PROGRAMME AND INFORMATION

The 2012 Laser SB3 Inland Championship is being held at Rutland Sailing Club. This is the first Class event of the year.

The Club is located near Edith Weston on the South shore of Rutland Water. For details how to get there see Club website www.rutlandsc.co.uk, or enter “LE15 8HJ” in your SatNav. The Club is less than 3 hours from the Hamble River. However for those from Scotland it is longer!

Racing

See the Notice of Race. For the Inland Championship there is a schedule of 9 races

We are also holding an additional separate “Ultimate Test Race”. Boats will compete for the prize for the fastest round one lap of the course, starting at any time within a time-window. This Ultimate Test Race will not form part of the Inland Championship series.

Arrival

Please arrive Friday morning after 8am.

However, you are welcome to arrive on Thursday if necessary: the Club will be open until 9.30pm. If you wish to arrive later than this on Thursday then please contact the office in advance, or phone Triff: contact details are overleaf.

Park your boats on the hard-standing to the left immediately on entering the site.

Launching/Recovery

For launching and recovery you will be using your boat trailers (it is fresh water!)

All boats will be launched by tractors manned by club volunteers during Friday morning. This will enable speedy launching of arrivals so please do not use your own cars for launching during this time.

Boats arriving later or earlier than Friday morning may have to use their own cars to launch – there are pontoons alongside the slipways to make things easy. Recovery of all boats on Sunday afternoon will be by the manned tractors.

Mooring

As soon as they are launched the boats should move away from the pontoons to their moorings in order to make room for the boats launching later. We will have RIBs to help you do this, as the use of outboard engines is not permitted on the Water (see also Notice of Race 14.2)

After racing the boats will go direct to their moorings: please ensure that there are lines on your boat to tie up to these moorings. RIBs will bring you ashore.
